

As a **Maintenance Technician (Aquatics)** you will be maintaining and carrying out troubleshooting exercises for mechanical and electrical equipment/components of all the exciting rides in the water park. This position provides all of the necessary repairs and preventative maintenance required to preserve and improve the physical functionality, safety and appearance of the all rides, attractions and facilities in order to ensure Guest satisfaction. Other responsibilities:

- Performing planned preventative maintenance in order to prevent any future equipment failures.
- Maintaining appropriate records throughout the department in order to ensure the efficient flow of information.
- Performing safety inspections of all rides, ride surfaces, ride structural integrity and general building safety in order to maintain a safe environment for our guests.
- Assisting different teams during events and special functions in order to contribute to the success of the organization.
- Reporting any safety concerns to management in order to maintain the highest standard of safety and hygiene at all times.
- Responding to service requests in a timely and courteous manner.
- Maintaining all tools and equipment in good repair and working condition.

In order to be considered for the position you must have at least 2 years' experience as Maintenance Technician in a water park/theme park or its equivalent. You must have a certificate/diploma in Engineering and good command of spoken and written English.
